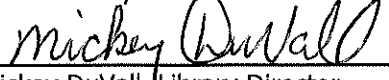

Librarian's Report
June 2, 2014

1. Library Statistics for the month of April. Circulation statistics are down 4% compared to April 2013; gate count is down 18% compared to April 2013; programming is up 26% compared to April 2013; Internet usage is down 7% compared to April 2013; reference requests are up 45% compared to April 2013 and meeting room reservations are down 27% compared to April 2013.
2. In the month of May 243 children and adults attended story time.
3. On Thursday, May 1 Bonnie Pierson, Melissa Bullara and Cary Kittrell each taught a library class to three age groups of homeschoolers. In total, nineteen home schooled students attended classes.
4. On Thursday, May 1 Ashley Guerrero hosted a Teen Advisory Board meeting. Sixteen teens attended the meeting. Teens talked about some ideas for future Anime meetings and discussed what kind of theme they would like to have for the Teen Volunteer Party.

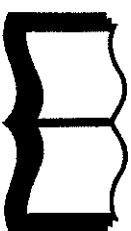

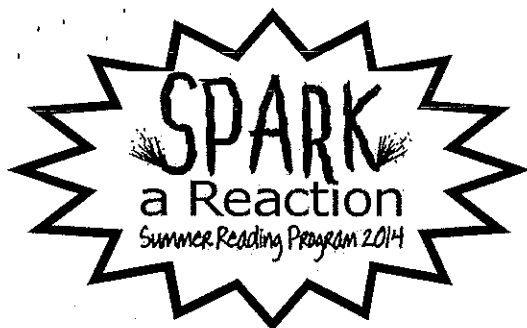

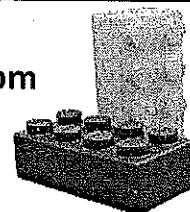

Do I have to read library books?
